## **Second Annual Report to the Community**

## ADDENDUM - April 25, 2005

As a follow-up to our Second Annual Report to the Community dated December 31, 2004, the Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC) is pleased to provide the following information.

We recently received the independent financial and performance audit reports from the CPA firm of Hartley, May & Abrahamsen for Measures S & T for fiscal year July 1, 2003 - June 30, 2004. Measure S bond proceeds are intended for facilities improvements at Eureka High School and Zane and Winship middle schools, while Measure T bonds are to cover improvements at the district's elementary schools. Of the \$43,160,000 bonds authorized by the March 2002 election, \$28,099,592 were sold in August 2002. The financial activity of the two bond measures during the 2003-04 fiscal year is summarized as follows:

The independent audit report states that bond funds "were used for specified school facilities projects only, as described in Measures S & T, and not for teacher or administrator salaries and other operating expenses." We agree with the findings of the audits.
