Audit Report: Assistant Superintendent Johnson reported the audit for Measures S & T was approved at the March 7, 2007 Governing Board meeting. In addition to the independent auditor's report he explained a breakdown by site, for each of the bonds, provided by Parsons 3D/I. Projects at Grant and Lafavette are nearing completion and staff continues to find resources to remodel the Lafayette office.

Annual Report to the Community: Sue Alton reported she is continuing to work on the report started by former Chair Karen Suiker and will email a draft to the committee soon.

Construction Progress Update: Program Manager Barbie Warren explained the changes to the campus quad at Eureka High School. The green-space area has been amended to save cost, keep the building which formerly housed the tech center, and recapture parking lost in the initial plan. Slides of projects by sites with budgets, showing the original budget, change orders and the total cost, construction start dates and final completion dates were shown. Sheldon Reber, Director of School and Community Relations shared slides of the elevator installation in the main building at Eureka High School. The elevator is due to be operational by the start of school next August.
