V. <u>STAFF REPORTS</u>

Committee Membership Status: Chairperson Suiker reported that Robert Averill, representing middle/high school, has resigned. The committee historically has been comprised of nine (9) members but remains compliant with Proposition 39 which states the committee shall consist of at least seven (7) members with associated representation.

Website Financial Update: The committee discussed the 3D/I construction management website. Due to staffing changes the website has not been kept up-to-date. Assistant Superintendent Johnson added that Eureka City Schools' website is up-to-date and the public is welcome to call the office for assistance.

<u>Audit Status</u>: The S & T audit was handed out to the committee. Assistant Superintendent Johnson explained this is an independent audit specific to the bond addressing that bond dollars were spent appropriately and the dollars match their appropriation. He also explained project management fees.

Construction progress Update: A handout was provided by Barbie Warren, 3D/I Program Manager. Assistant Superintendent Johnson reported the EHS Wood Shop is on the Board agenda January 24th for final completion. EHS Modernization: service drive paved today, the IE Community Media Center interior demolition is complete, work continues on the walkway between IA and science, the library seismic work was completed over winter break (one week ahead of schedule) and the handrails were installed on the ramp in front of the main building. Grant Elementary: Dinsmore Construction continues working on the Student Services Building scheduled to be completed mid-February. Lafayette Elementary: final completion is on the Board agenda for January 24th. He also added that approximately 85% of the work has been done by local contractors.
