Measure S

<u>Elementary Schools</u>: All four elementary schools' security camera installs have been completed.

Alice Birney: Cafeteria floor is being repaired/modernized to polished concrete.

Zane: Floors in Building 4 are being abated and then will be repaired/modernized to polished concrete.

<u>EHS Gym:</u> Not on schedule. Punchlist walk will need to happen and worked through. The center court logo from the old gym is being set in the floor of the lobby in the new gym. The original center court "E" will be hung on the wall of the lobby. Abatement contractors are coming up next week to assess the old gym. The grand opening is scheduled in August. <u>EHS Science Building:</u> This is a modernization project so there have been many unforeseen issues and change orders, which is driving up the project cost.

Measure T

The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for Increment #1 came in at \$23.6M. The storm drain alone is \$11M. The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC) came up to meet with the District to look at the project and discuss how to fund the shortfall. OPSC agreed that this is an extremely unique project. They do not have anything to compare this project to.

The ECS Board decided to pause the project until we have Increment #2 back from the Division of the State Architect (DSA) and the amount of funding we will expect to receive through OPSC.

5. Annual Report to the Community

The report was sent to the committee to review. Becky will report out to the Board at the June 1, 2023 meeting.

6. COC Membership

Becky recommended two people to apply to the vacant COC position and said that there is also a third that expressed interest. Paul will reach out to them.
