Funds to help english learning parents become fluent/hiring those parents as translators Why is Washington allocated more funds than Alice Birney Students/teachers/families need to be the largest deciding factor in these decisions Flat 20K, give Wellness staff and students autonomy over funds 20K+3X weighted average Can this money be used on support staff/training How is the weighted numbers calculated Funds need to be allocated to ensure all families are included (interpreters, translators, transportation to school events) Weighted average 3X with 20K flat is best option 20K+3X How will resources looks different between younger students and ones who are less dependent on parents Weighted average 3X with 20K flat is the most equity based.
